**SHERIFF SCOTT ADAMS ENDORSES TODD CREEK**

*Retiring Sheriff Adams Backs Creek as the Right Choice to Carry the Office Forward*

**ELKTON, MD** — Outgoing Cecil County Sheriff Scott Adams has announced his endorsement of Sgt. Harold "Todd" Creek for Cecil County Sheriff in the 2026 election. Sheriff Adams, who is retiring after serving three terms and 12 years leading the Cecil County Sheriff's Office, cited Creek's distinguished career and firsthand knowledge of his capabilities as the basis for his support.

Sheriff Adams and Creek share a decades-long professional relationship rooted in the Sheriff's Office School Resource Officer (SRO) program. Adams previously served as an SRO and as the SRO Unit Supervisor before his election as Sheriff. Creek was promoted to Supervisor of the SRO Unit upon Adams' election — a role Creek has held since December 2014.

"Todd has earned this endorsement every day of his career," said Sheriff Adams. "I've watched him work — up close, in the field, and in the community. He is the kind of leader who does the hard work quietly, builds trust with the people around him, and never loses sight of why this job matters. Cecil County will be in good hands."

Creek has served with the Cecil County Sheriff's Office for 18 years, including roles in Patrol, Criminal Investigations, and the Crimes Against Children Unit. He served as a supervisor in the Civil Process Unit and Criminal Investigations Division before assuming leadership of the SRO Unit. He is a graduate of the Baltimore County Police Academy and holds national certifications as a D.A.R.E. and A.L.I.C.E. Instructor. His advanced training includes FBI-LEEDA Supervisor Training, Crisis Intervention Training, and graduation from the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police Command and Leadership Academy.

"I am honored by the endorsement of Sheriff Adams," said Creek. "His support and trust mean a great deal to me and I intend to honor that and take this office forward with the same dedication to the citizens of Cecil County."
